- 4. BPP Workbooks are required by all students. Students have the option to request eBooks instead of physical copies.
- 5. Fees quoted are exclusive of fees payable direct to ACCA:
 - Student Membership and Examination fees (charged at the prevailing rate)
 - Freight for any hard copy materials
- 6. Fees quoted are inclusive of:
 - BPP ECR including slides, practice questions, marked assignments, mock exams, and other resources (including required knowledge from previous modules)
 - Harley Reed classes, revision and tutorial support
- 7. Unless otherwise agreed, all fees must be paid in full prior to admittance to a course and provision of study support. Students agree to the prevailing Harley Reed Terms and Conditions and must complete the online registration process.
